He is also the Education Delegate of the Section USA of the ITI. Dr. Martin is a member of numerous professional organizations including the Academy of Osseointegration and ADA. He has authored numerous peer-reviewed scientific articles and abstracts and has co-authored several textbooks on implant dentistry. He lectures both nationally and internationally on esthetic and implant dentistry.

He received his DMD with honors from the University of Florida and completed his MS and Certificate in Prosthodontics from Baylor College of Dentistry.
