



Tour of Provence & the Côte D'Azur: A playground for movie stars today, Provence was once a Roman province that proudly retains its ancient history and happily flaunts its foodie and regional specialties. We'll begin our stay in Avignon at the Hotel d'Europe, whose illustrious guest list includes Victor Hugo, Pablo Picasso and Jackie Kennedy! Seat of the Popes in the 14th Century, Avignon is a perfect jumping off point for day trips in the region.

The wineries of Chateauneuf-du-Pape beckon for wine tastings and then it's off to the ancient city of Carpentras. A Chef Day at the indoor market of Les Halles will provide a hands-on lesson in Provençal cooking and its aromatic spices. Tuesday is market day in Saint-Remy-de-Provence and not to be missed! The tour of the Alpilles region also includes stops in Les Baux de Provence and Les Carrières de Lumières. Next, it is off for a day in the Camargue region, known for its white horses, black bulls, pink flamingoes and most especially, its salt marshes off the Mediterranean coast. Stops include the Ornithological Park of the Pont du Gau, the fortified town of Aigues Mortes and Les-Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer. Arles' landscapes painted by Van Gogh will top off the day.

We then bid adieu to Avignon and head to Aix-en-Provence, where the Counts of Provence once reigned, and stay at the Grand Hotel du Roi René, named for the last count to rule the region. On the way over we will stop in Salon-de-Provence and visit the 120+ year old Marius Fabre natural soap factory. Over the weekend in Aix, there will be a free day to visit the daily markets and the Cours Mirabeau among other highlights. Sunday will be a true foodie day, starting with a visit to the Musée du Calisson du Roy René. Next it is off to the Luberon region and to Lourmarin for a taste of the Appellation Ventoux wines. Desert will be found at the Maison du Fruit Confit, a "savoir-faire" that dates back more than 2,000 years. We will walk off all of those calories in the small town of Roussillon that sits on a ridge of ochre cliffs and its Sentiers des Ogres that takes visitors through the former quarries.

Our next destination is the glittering shores of the Cote d'Azur, where we will stay at the Hotel Boscolo Exedra Nice. We'll break up the journey with a beach stop in Saint-Tropez and continue on to Grasse, headquarters for perfumers the world over. The next day, we'll take a walking tour of Nice and its Promenade des Anglais, the ancient Greek and Roman sites and the Lympia harbor. Finally, we'll take a full day tour of the French Riviera starting in Saint-Jean Cap Ferrat, before heading to the hilltop village of Èze and ultimately the tiny principality of Monaco. Of course, a visit to Monaco wouldn't be complete without a tour of the Formula 1 race track, a tour of the capital Monte Carlo and some free time to stroll, before ending the day with a farewell dinner!

Paris Pre-Tour (May 16-19) and Riviera Extension (May 31 – June 2): For those that wish to extend their trip, join us for a weekend pre-tour in Paris kicking it into high gear at the Moulin Rouge, a full day tour of Paris and Versailles, a day for shopping and then a transfer to the TGV station before heading south. After the main tour of Provence, we'll visit the Italian Riviera, known for its markets, picturesque streets and more gourmet delights! The next day, enjoy a half day tour of Cannes, before heading to the peninsula of Antibes, Juan-les-Pins and Cap d'Antibes with its 16th century ramparts, grand villas and the glamorous Hôtel du Cap-Eden-Roc. Enjoy some free time on the second to last day so you can plan your next visit to the South of France and the many stops we didn't get to see!

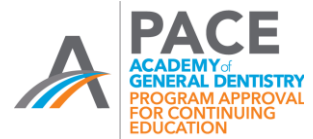
