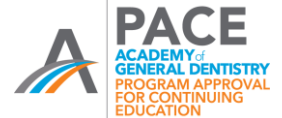

Dr. Ronald Perry is Director of the Gavel Center for Restorative Research and Clinical Professor at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine. He owns and manages a private general dentistry practice, Meridian Dental Associates, in South Weymouth, MA.

He has authored over 25 articles and 60 abstracts dealing with a variety of dental topics such as bonding, composite wear, prosthodontic materials and technology, whitening, and dental laboratory communication. Dr. Perry is a Fellow in the Academy of General Dentistry, the American College of Dentists, the International College of Dentists and the Academy of Dentistry International.

He graduated summa cum laude with a B.S. from Boston College and earned his doctorate in dentistry from Boston University. He completed his M.S. in Dental Research at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine.
